Rules and Conditions

Please read the rules, failure to comply might lead to disqualification. The *Judge's decision is final!*)

General

- 1. The hall will be open for delivery of exhibits from 9.30am to 11.30am on the day of the show.
- 2. No persons, other than those officials engaged, will be allowed in the Hall after 11.30am, or while judging is taking place, until the show opens.
- 3. Exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor, with the exception of Section 3 Floral Art.
- 4. Anyone acting in contravention of the above rule will, on detection, forfeit any prizes he/she may have been awarded.
- 5. No exhibitor can enter more than **two** exhibits in one class.
- 6. Exhibitors to provide all vases, containers, plates etc as may be necessary.
- 7. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the committee will not be responsible for any damage or loss.
- 8. Stewards reserve the right to move exhibits to facilitate judging, as necessary.
- Certificates will be awarded for the 1st 2nd and 3rd BEST ENTRIES in the individual sections.
- 10. Where there is insufficient merit or entries, prizes may be withheld. The judges' decisions are final in all cases of merit.
- 11. No exhibit to be removed before the prize giving.
- 12. Any items not claimed may be sold, together with produce donated, to benefit the show/charity.

Section Rules:

Floral Art

Unnatural materials are to be used only as accessories

Cookery Guidance

All items must be home-made. Items that are still warm may be disqualified. All items made at home must comply with food safety standards (attached) and will require a list of ingredients to be displayed with them including all allergens.

Photography

The entrant must gain permission from anyone who appears in their photograph. Photographs, either colour or black and white, must be no larger than $8'' \times 6''$ (203mm x 105mm), can be simply mounted but unframed OR A4 unmounted and unframed.
